## Shipshape art show comes to Greenwich

Art Greenwich, a five-day cultural event aboard SeaFair, America's Megayacht Venue, will be held September 15 through 19 at the marina of the Delamar Hotel in Greenwich Harbor. The show will feature an array of dealers from around the world offering artwork, sculpture, and jewelry.

Artworks of all periods, beginning with early 16th century Durer master prints, paintings from 17th to late 19th century of the American Hudson River School, luminist style, British sporting and European schools of art will be on exhibit and will be for sale.

Among the artists presented at Art Greenwich will be Thomas Cole, Childe Hassam, Mark Cassatt, Pierre-Auguste Renoir and Winslow Homer.

A full range of contemporary and emerging artists' work-- paintings, sculpture, photography along with mid-20th century objects d'art from French and American designers representing Deco, avant-garde and Italian Futurism design will be showcased.

In addition, period 20th century signed jewelry by Verdura, David Webb, Van Cleef & Arpels, Yves Saint Laurent, Boucheron, Buccellati, Bulgari, Chaumet, Chopard and Sterle, George Jensen, Tiffany & Co, Cartier and Madame Gripoix's Chanel Jewelry and new jewelry designed by Yvel and Jewels by Viggì and 18th and 19th Century estate jewelry will be featured.

Art Greenwich's full range of pieces includes antique objects d'art- porcelain, ceramics and pottery complemented by modern and mid-century Murano glass.

History enthusiasts will have an opportunity to admire rare 50 million year-old fossils used as art from the Eocene Era.

The event will include an extensive collection of modern and contemporary masters, including works by Pablo Picasso, Joan Miro, Alexander Calder, Salvador Dali, Camille Pissarro, Robert Reichenberger, Alex Katz, Sam Francis, Jim Dine, Keith Haring, Julian Opie, Helen Frankenthaler, Marlene Rose, Tolla Inbar, Luis Efe Velez, Zanny Migdal, Arman, Ira Sapir, Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein.

A special exhibition "Made in China" presenting the works of 17 contemporary Chinese artists whose works span from the mid-90s to today will also be showcased.

### Hours and Ticket Prices

Art Greenwich will be docked at the Delamar Harbor at 500 Steamboat Road. Easily accessible parking can be found next to the hotel. Fair hours will be Friday and Saturday, September 15 and 16 from 11 am to 9 pm and Sunday and Monday, September 18 and 19, from 11 am to 7 pm. Tickets are \$15 for a one-day pass, \$20 for a one-day priority admission, \$30 for a multi-day pass or all can be purchased in advance at a discounted fair price on the Expoships website. Children under 10 are free.
